

## WHO TO CONTACT IF YOU ARE A VICTIM OF IDENTITY THEFT

1. Contact the Local Police Department
2. Call your financial institution
3. Call your credit card companies
4. Place a fraud alert on your Credit Report
5. File a complaint with the Federal Trade Commission
6. File a report with the IC3.gov if the fraud is computer related
7. File a report with the Attorney General
